

Log In to the JA Learning Platform


- 1. Open your web browser (latest version of Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, or Apple Safari recommended) and go to https://learn.ja.org.
 - A. Enter your username and password and select LOGIN.
 - B. Select Forgot Password to reset your password.




(NOTE: Users who had login credentials on the previous JA Learning Platform (CK) will use the same login credentials as they did for CK. New users will receive an automated email from JASA to create their login.)




• Enter your email address and select RESET PASSWORD.



2. If this is your first time logging in, you will receive an email from Junior Achievement to setup your password.



3. On your first login, review the Junior Achievement - Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. Select the **check box** to agree and select **SAVE**.

Navbar




- Content takes a user into the course materials
- Assignments where students access and submit graded student activities
- Quizzes knowledge based surveys for students
- Surveys attitudinal surveys for students
- Classlist** roster of students enrolled in the course for vol and educators
- Class Progress roster of student progress through course and grades
- Course Admin** a single page with links to the features listed above
- ** Class List and Course Admin are not available in a Student account.

NOTE: Not every course offers every feature that you see in this Instructional Guide. Contact your local JA Area staff for the **Features by Program** document to see which features are available in each program.


D2L Homepage vs Course Homepage

If you are enrolled in multiple courses your home screen will be the D2L Home screen.



If you are enrolled in a single course, your home screen will be the JA Course Home.





Home Button

To get back to the D2L Home Screen, select the Junior Achievement logo, in the top left corner.



Notifications

To view Update Alerts, click on the bell icon. This is where a student would see that they have a new graded assignment.




Language Settings | View Course Content in Spanish

Follow these steps to view the course content in Spanish:

From the Course Home page, select the **Español** module tile to access the course content in Spanish.





Language Settings | View D2L in Spanish


Follow these steps to change your preferred language to Spanish:

- 1. Select your name in the top banner to open your options menu.
- 2. Select the language.



3. Set your Preferred Language. Save.





Switch to Student View

- 1. Select your name in the top banner to open your options menu.
- 2. Select View as Student from the menu options.



4. Select X to cancel Viewing as Student.






Preparing to Deliver a Course

Access Course Content

From the Course Home page, select the **module tile** you want to access in the Visual Table of Contents Widget section.



Access Educator & Volunteer Guides


From the Course Home page, select Content from the Nav bar

Note: Elementary courses include the Educator and Volunteer Guide on the Program Overview and Resource Page. They are not located inside the folders.






The Icon means the content is hidden from the Student View.

Use the icons in the top right corner to


- Open the presentation in a new tab.

View tutorial video


When you get to a quiz, at the beginning or end of a session or program. Quizzes are the knowledge-based survey questions.



Select Quizzes from the Nav bar.




Click on the down arrow, then select Preview.






Here, you can view Quiz Details and Instructions. Click Start Quiz to see the Quiz questions that a student will answer.



Review Quiz Results



From the quiz screen, click on Statistics




From this screen, you will see the class average and the individual grade of each student.






To view question details, select Question Stats




View the individual questions by selecting **Question Details**Information can be exported from any of these pages, by selecting **Export to CSV** or **Export to Excel**






Reset a Quiz Attempt

Select Quizzes on the Nav bar. Select the down arrow. Select Grade.




Check the box next to attempt that you want to delete. Select Reset.






Select Yes.




Preview a Survey

Review survey questions, then select Exit Preview.







Preview an Assignment

An Assignment can be accessed from the Nav bar.




Select Edit Assignment. You cannot edit the assignment, but this is how you would access it to review.




Click on the Assignment.






You will see a preview of the assignment and can download or print directly from this page.




Grade an Assignment

Select the file name to see the full submission. Provide feedback, record audio or video on the right side of the screen and **Publish**






Continue to the next student assignment by selecting the > icon or the **User Submission** dropdown list.

Select Classlist on the Nav bar. Usernames are provided to support student logins.




Click on the dropdown arrow for additional options.


View Student Progress
